
Summary: The Lion

- The Lion is used to represent the Nation of Israel
- It is the specific Standard of Judah
- It is a symbol of the KING the Lord Jesus Christ
- It is used of Israel in the wilderness
- It is used of Israel in the age to come
- It represents the voice of prophecy
- It is a symbol of judgment

STANDARD OF JUDAH On the south side shall be the standard (banner) of the camp of Reuben according to their armies: and the captain of the children of Reuben shall be Elizur the son of Shedeur.


Summary: The Man

- Reuban was Judah's firstborn son
- The MAN is obviously a symbol of Flesh
 but GOD manifest in the Flesh
- The MAN represents the nation of Israel God's NATIONAL SON
- The MAN is a title of the Lord Jesus Christ God's only begotten son
- The saint are also described as "sons of God"
 - "One like the SON OF MAN" is a phrase used of the saints throughout the prophets and represents the multitudinous Christ







Summary: The Ox

- The Ox is used to represent the Nation of Israel
- It is a symbol of the Labourer
- It is a symbol of humilty & thankfullness
- Christ took on the form of a servant -the ox, and asks us to take his yoke upon us.
- It is used of Israel in the age to come in judgement of nations

STANDARD OF EPHRAIM The standard (banner) of the camp of Dan shall be on the north side by their armies: and the captain of the children of Dan shall be Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.










If we would rule as the lion

We must first manifest the spirit in our flesh (the Man)









Definition: Covering

Strongs #3727 - Kapporeth

a covering, from root "to cover", only used of the cover of the ark of the covenant, the inmost recess of the temple, where the ark of the covenant was placed.

And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.


Mercy Seat: #2434 hilasmos - Propitiation



1 John 2:1-2

My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation (coveringmercy seat) for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.



And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubims be. (v20)

Summary: Cherubim on the Mercy Seat


- The Cherubim were part of the COVERING of the Ark, the Mercy Seat
- They protected the TESTIMONY or COVENANT that would KEEP Israel in the WAY
- Christ is the MERCY SEAT
- The CHERUBIM upon it are symbolic of the MULTITUDINOUS Christ
- Their focus is first on Christ then upon their brethren

And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

THE SYMBOLIC THRONE OF GOD



Strongs #3427 - Yashab

to sit, sit down, to be set, to remain, stay, to dwell, have one's abode, to inhabit



Yahweh reigneth; let the people tremble: he <u>sitteth</u> between the cherubim; let the earth be moved.

Psalm 99:1

Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, thou that leadest Joseph like a flock; thou that <u>dwellest</u> between the cherubim, <u>shine</u> forth.

Summary

- The Cherubim were the focal point where God would appear to Israel - in a cloud
- God would communicate with Israel from between the Cherubim - like Eden
- God inhabited the Cherubim dwelt there
- This was his symbolic throne in the midst of the nation of Israel
- He would "Shine forth" and indicate his acceptance from this place.











And within the oracle he made two cherubims of olive tree, each ten cubits high... both the cherubims were of one measure and one size... And he set the cherubims within the inner house: and they stretched forth the wings of the cherubim, so that the wing of the one touched the one wall, and the wing of the other cherub touched the other wall; and their wings touched one another in the midst of the house. And he overlaid the cherubim with gold.
