## 1 John 4

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

**Sent** #649 • *apostello* • **verb** • **to order one to go** to a place appointed

Propitiation #2434 • hilasmos • noun in Hebrew – "expiation" (extinguishing guilt) or making atonement. Used in the LXX in place of the Hebrew verb for "to expiate". Noun Related to the word #2435 • hilasterion • derived from #2433 • having an expiating force (ability to extinguish guilt), used of the cover the ark in the Holy of Hollies – sprinkled with blood.

Ought #3784 · opheilei · verb · to owe, be indebted, the goodwill due




